Maumee Valley Guidance Center is proud to offer therapists with specialized training to work with military connected individuals, including active duty, veterans, Guard, Reserve, and family members. Star Behavioral Health Providers are therapists that have completed courses with content created by the Center for Deployment Psychology. Star Behavioral Health Providers must complete a three-tiered training program:

- Tier One is an introduction to military culture, gives information about the deployment cycle and educates the therapists on proper terminology, ranks, and acronyms.
- Tier Two provides education about specific challenges and difficulties that are often associated with military service.
- Tier Three provides evidence-based treatment education for behavioral health issues facing service members, veterans & families. These evidence-based treatments include Prolonged Expose Therapy for Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and Assessing and Treating Suicidal Ideation in the military.

Participating in therapy with a clinician who has specialized training in military culture allows the person to express themselves while feeling confident that the clinician understands military dynamics and culture. Pursuing treatment with individuals trained in military culture can assist in building a more positive rapport and aid in a more complete, successful treatment experience.
